Delivering First Aid Programs

The Lifesaving Society offers a comprehensive first aid and CPR program, including Workplace Standard First Aid. Most First Aid awards can be taught using the Canadian Lifesaving Manual – no extra books needed – and by Lifesaving Society Instructors.

The Society’s Lifesaving Instructors are already certified to teach Basic First Aid, CPR-A, B and C, and Emergency First Aid with CPR-B.

Our Standard First Aid Instructors are certified to teach the Society’s Workplace Standard First Aid certification, AED and Anaphylaxis Rescuer.

For those taking first aid training outside the lifesaving program, the Society’s Canadian First Aid Manual offers a complete first aid resource – English or French – for only \$15.20. Candidates in the Society’s AED and Anaphylaxis Rescuer courses would require this manual.

Programming First Aid with Lifesaving and Lifeguarding courses

Combining First Aid certifications with other Lifesaving Society courses is an efficient use of everyone’s time, and ensures candidates have the required prerequisites for their next Lifesaving Society course. Programming is easy. Just add a few additional hours to your courses (see chart).

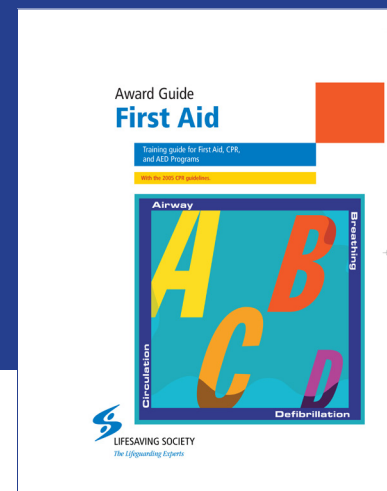
As of January 1, 2015 Emergency First Aid will become a prerequisite to Bronze Cross. To make sure your Bronze Medallion candidates are prepared, we recommend programming Emergency First Aid with Bronze Medallion.

Combining Workplace Standard First Aid with Bronze Cross is an effective way to prepare your candidates for work as assistant lifeguards – no extra courses needed.
