The Lifesaving Society New Brunswick hosts the 2024 Canadian Surf Lifesaving Championships August 23 to 25, 2024 at Parlee Beach Provincial Park and is seeking certified officials to fill available positions.

In preparation, the Society has scheduled four online training opportunities for individuals interested in obtaining the officials certifications required to officiate at the Championships.

Each option below includes both the Community Official course and the Open Water Official course. Candidates need only attend one of the four options:

- 1. February 3, all day
- 2. April 23 and 25, 6:00-9:00 p.m.
- 3. June 12 and 13, 6:00–9:00 p.m.
- 4. August 11, all day

Registration fee: \$70 Registration deadline: One week prior to the start date of each course.
